TERMS ASSOCIATED WITH NON-TENURE TRACK FACULTY TITLES Updated: April 5, 2021

The RBHS Policies and Guidelines Governing Appointments, Promotions, and Professional Activities (A & P Guidelines) of the Faculty speak to the length of faculty appointments; they can be found at https://facultyaffairs.rbhs.rutgers.edu/appointments-promotions/faculty-appointments-and-promotions-guidelines/. The A & P Guidelines apply faculty whose primary appointment is to a legacy UMDNJ school, department, Center, Institute or program in RBHS but not to faculty whose primary appointment is in legacy Rutgers with an FTE of greater than 0.5.

Please find below a brief summary of the term lengths for the non-tenure tracks. Please review the A & P Guidelines for the full and specific language.

Teaching, Clinical, and Professional Practice:

Assistant Professor: 1 - 3 year renewable appt

Associate Professor:

- Initial Appt: 1 − 5 year
- Promoted to Associate Professor or Initial Associate Professor appt renewed: 2 5 year renewable appt
- After 10 years as Associate Professor: 3 5 year renewable appt

Professor:

- Initial Appt: 1 5 year renewable appt
- Promoted to Professor or Initial Professor appt renewed: 3 5 year renewable appt
- After 10 years as Professor: 3 7 year renewable appt

Distinguished Professor:

- Initial Appt: 1 5 year renewable appt
- Promoted to Distinguished Professor or Initial Distinguished Professor apptrenewed:
 3 5 year renewable appt
- After 10 years as Distinguished Professor: 3 7 year renewable appt

Research:

All faculty receive 1 - 3 year contracts
